Many thanks to Charisse Whistler for the 'facelift' given to the Grade 7 girls' toilets. What a difference!

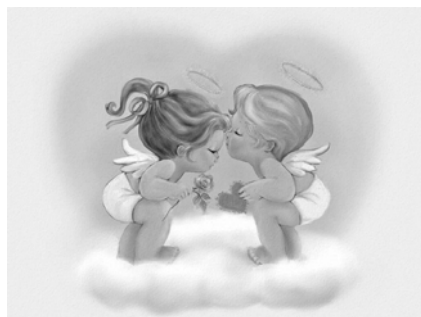
### LOIS BASSETT MEMORIAL GALA
